**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
TO FILE MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION OF ORDER NO. 7393**

ABACO Energy Services, LLC (“ABACO”), hereby requests an extension of time to file its Motion for Reconsideration of this Commission’s determinations in Order No. 7393.


On February 4, 2015, the undersigned counsel first appeared in this Docket on behalf of ABACO because its prior counsel, John Alke, had retired from the private practice of law. On or about February 18, 2015, this Commission issued Order No. 7393 denying ABACO’s then-pending Motion to Dismiss (an Errata Notice was issued on February 19, 2015). The motion, briefing, argument, and determination on the Motion to Dismiss all occurred prior to the undersigned counsel being retained by ABACO. Any motion for reconsideration of this Commission’s Order No. 7393 must be filed on February 28, 2015.

ABACO believes grounds for reconsideration may exist and has requested the undersigned counsel to research and make such motion as appropriate. However, because of prior commitments to other clients, including out of town commitments this week and next week, and the preparation for a 7 day trial scheduled to begin on March 16, 2015 in the First Judicial District Court (Judge Menahan, presiding), the undersigned counsel requests this Commission grant additional time to ABACO to file any motion for reconsideration.

Pursuant to this Commission's rules of procedure as set forth in its Blue Book, Commission staff attorneys may extend the deadline for reconsideration up to 30 days, or waive the automatic denial under Admin. R. Mont. 38.2.4806(5). Given the prior commitments of counsel, ABACO requests an extension of time to file any motion for reconsideration until Friday, March 13, 2015. This request allows ABACO's counsel an additional two weeks to become familiar with all the arguments made by ABACO's legal predecessors, the other parties, the Commission's Staff, and the Commissioners and to research and properly brief any grounds for reconsideration.
