NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO INTERVENE IN COMPLAINT PROCEEDING

On April 24, 2015, the Montana Public Service Commission (Commission) ordered that the following claim in the Shoshone Condominium Hotel Owner’s Association (“Shoshone”) Complaint shall proceed: the request that the Commission regulate ABACO Energy Services, L.L.C. (“ABACO”) and its charges for propane at Big Sky, Montana. The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Title 69, Chapter 3 of the Montana Code Annotated. The Commission will conduct this proceeding as a contested case pursuant to the Montana Administrative Procedures Act. Mont. Code Ann. §§ 2-4-601 to -631, 69-3- 321 (2013); see also Admin. R. Mont. 38.2.2101-2107 (2015) (setting forth the Commission’s complaint proceedings). A copy of the Shoshone’s Complaint, Order No. 7393, and Order No. 7393a are available for inspection at the Commission’s business offices at the address below and on its website.

Any interested person who is directly affected by the claim relating to ABACO’s and its charges for propane at Big Sky, Montana, which is in Shoshone’s Complaint, and who wants to be a party to the docket must file a Petition to Intervene with the Commission no later than **June 9, 2015** (intervention deadline).

By the intervention deadline, a person petitioning for intervention must: (1) Submit the petition electronically (e-file) on the Commission's website at <http://psc.mt.gov> ("Account Login/Registration" under "Electronic Documents" tab); and (2) physically deliver or mail the original petition to the Commission at 1701 Prospect Avenue, Helena, MT 59620. The Commission will not post an e-filed petition to its website until it receives the original from the petitioner. A person petitioning for intervention in this docket must also serve a hard copy of the petition on the Shoshone's Attorney, J.
