

- a. Provide a balance sheet for Commnet operations in Montana that reflects activity since Commnet began operating in Montana.

- d. What percentage of Commnet's revenues in Montana are made up from federal funds distributed by USAC through the Lifeline program for eligible Montana and/or Northern Cheyenne Reservation residents?

Response: These materials are confidential and entitled to trade secret protection under the Commission's rules. A motion for protective order has been filed with these responses. The documents will be filed pending the Commission's decision on Commnet's motion.

Supplemental Response: Commnet received its disbursement from the Lifeline program in June of 2017. Therefore, it is currently 0.4%.

- e. What percentage of Commnet's revenues in Montana are made up from revenues paid directly from Tribal and Non-Tribal customers who reside in Montana/Northern Cheyenne Reservation?

Response: These materials are confidential and entitled to trade secret protection under the Commission's rules. A motion for protective order has been filed with these responses. The documents will be filed pending the Commission's decision on Commnet's motion.

Supplemental Response: Wholesale revenues can be considered non-tribal revenues since they are not paid directly by tribal customers. Retail revenues, including Lifeline revenues, can be considered tribal revenues. Retail revenues currently make up a very small percentage of total revenues. Commnet received its disbursement from the Lifeline program in June of 2017. Therefore, it is currently 0.4%.

- b. Provide a breakdown of all capital expenditures related to Commnet's buildout of its current network in Rosebud County.

Supplemental Response: The current network in Rosebud County consists of 4 cell site locations. Below are the expenses associated with the construction of those cell sites.

- d. Provide a breakdown of all capital expenditures related to Commnet's buildout of its current network in Big Horn County.

Supplemental Response: The current network in Big Horn County consists of 1 cell site location with 2 technologies. Please note Commnet's Petition for Designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier mistakenly states there are 2 cell towers in Big Horn County. Commnet's response to PSC-005(d) included the correct number of towers, which is stated again here.
